

Art Class Sydney

Material list for Drawing and Watercolour class

Please bring the following with you to the first class.

- Paper – A2 cartridge pad. 210 gsm minimum for use with mixed media
- Willow charcoal - medium size
- 2 bull dog clips
- Paper towel for rubbing back
- Hard eraser
- Ruler

A range of soft chalk pastel will be needed by the 3rd week

- Soft white, black, ochre yellow, burnt sienna, light blue is a good starting range

Watercolour and ink will be generally used from week 4-8

- Paper - you can use your cartridge for using ink and practicing watercolour, but some medium grain watercolour sheets, a4 is big enough, will give you a better result with watercolour (180gsm minimum)
- Masking tape
- Black ink - bamboo ink pen, a couple of small tins or jars to dilute ink (tuna tins are great)
- A couple of watercolour brushes - medium pointed brush and a Chinese calligraphy brush is very good for ink and large washes.
- A watercolour set - ultramarine blue, burnt Sienna, cadmium yellow in small tubes or a set of pans is good to start, if using tubes you will need a watercolour palette. Get a palette with wells and some space for mixing.
